“WHO ARE YOU?”

International Juried Exhibition

October 23 – November 29, 2020

Opening reception SATURDAY October 24, 1-4 PM

Deadline for submissions – Monday, **September 14** between 3-6 PM

- In this exhibit we ask you to explore **identity**. Whether you’ve embraced the identity assigned to you at birth or you have fashioned one cut from new cloth, what does identity mean to you? We ask you to consider the following questions:
- How is your identity informed by your ethnicity, who you love, your gender, your political or religious beliefs, the culture that resonates within you? How has your identity changed over the years? In what ways has your identity shaped or changed your life? Does the world see and accept you for who you are?
- Allow your art to give voice to that which you personally define as identity. It can be very personal, or it can highlight a person or a cause that is about the concept.
- We invite two- and three-dimensional art. Think portraits, landscapes, abstract, photos, collages, paintings, sculptures, fiber arts, clay, paper, sound installation, video.

ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS:

NON-REFUNDABLE ENTRY FEES

SCA Members \$20 per entry or 3 entries for \$45 (basic membership is \$50 annually)

Non-members \$25 per entry or 3 entries for \$60

Students under 21: \$15 per piece

AWARDS

\$300 Best of Show, Second place \$200, Third place \$100, Merit Awards. Student award first place \$100, Second \$50

ELIGIBILITY:

- Open to all artists worldwide.
- Maximum of 3 pieces (artwork) per artist.
- Wall hung work may not weigh over 50lbs.
- Wall hung work needs to include fixtures: wired and ready to hang.
- Artists receive 60% of the sales price of the work.
- All work must be original (no reproductions of original artwork)
- SCA reserves the right of refusal on all work that is too fragile to be displayed properly and safely.
- All work must NOT have been previously shown in the Gallery at SCA.

SELECTION:

- Work will be selected from hand delivered work and online applications.
- The juror will view all work in an anonymous manner.

- **if you will NOT hand deliver your work to SCA, use EntryThingy.com to upload images.** This can be done any time before September 14, but deadline is September 14. First time using entrythingy.com? Do not wait until the day of the deadline. EntryThingy has its own FAQ to help you, and can be reached via email if you have problems: Hello@entrythingy.com. Make sure all images you upload are 5 megabytes or less in size and are in JPEG format. If not, EntryThingy will not let them be uploaded. Resize if necessary, before starting. - Each entry/piece can have one main image and up to two views (to show perspective or detail). - We advise that you submit high quality images that best represent your work. Works that differ from the submission image may not be included in the exhibition. When filling out forms, make an entry in each field. You may use "N/A" if the field does not apply. When entering more than one image per piece, enter the main image then up to 2 detailed views, before clicking on 'next'. - Pay via PayPal.

ENTRIES THAT HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED

- Work can be shipped or hand delivered.
- Selected work is to arrive by Saturday, October 17, 4 PM LATEST but can be shipped or hand delivered ANY TIME BEFORE October 17, during gallery hours. (See gallery hours below)

SHIPPING

- Mail to SCA, 282 S. High St, Sebastopol, CA 95472 to arrive by October 17 (or any time before, during gallery hours). Attn. Catherine Devriese.
- Artist is responsible for all shipping and handling costs to and from the exhibit.
- Each shipped entry must be packaged in a reusable container for the return of work.
- Each shipped entry MUST include a return label and a prepaid return shipping form (UPS or FedEx).
- Unsold work, with valid return forms for shipping, will be sent within 15 days after last day of the show.

LIABILITY, SALES etc. REGARDING WORK SUBMITTED:

- Selected work must be on view for the duration of the exhibit. No work may be withdrawn prior to close of the exhibition.
- Selected artists agree to allow work to be photographed for media use, for educational and publicity purposes.
- Artists receive 60% of the sales price of work that is sold. Indicate clearly on form if not for sale NFS. - Sales occurring as a result of the exhibit up to 30 days after closing date are subject to 40% of commission.
